

Michaud Announces Funding for Eastport Municipal Airport and Hancock County-Bar Harbor Airport

WASHINGTON, DC – Today, Congressman Michaud announced that the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) has awarded grants to the Eastport Municipal Airport and the Hancock County-Bar Harbor Airport. The Eastport Municipal Airport will receive \$170,000 in grant funds to build a fuel farm. The Hancock County-Bar Harbor Airport will receive a grant of \$380,000 to construct a runway safety area.

WASHINGTON, DC – Today, Congressman Michaud announced that the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) has awarded grants to the Eastport Municipal Airport and the Hancock County-Bar Harbor Airport. The Eastport Municipal Airport will receive \$170,000 in grant funds to build a fuel farm. The Hancock County-Bar Harbor Airport will receive a grant of \$380,000 to construct a runway safety area.

“These grants will go to fund much needed infrastructure improvements,” said Michaud. “The projects funded increase the safety and self-sufficiency of these airports, which will benefit the surrounding communities.”

The fuel farm at the Eastport Municipal Airport will raise revenue for the airport, helping it achieve self-sufficiency. The Hancock County-Bar Harbor Airport will use the grant to purchase a privately-owned parcel at the end of runway 22. Ownership of this property will give the airport the land it needs to build a safety area; complying with FAA standards.
